

Print anything you like to cut out and stick onto nesting dolls, although it can be a bit crinkly if the surface isn't completely flat. Cut little lines to help with this.

- Emoji faces are easily available on the internet to download and print, or copy, and cut out. Stick on with Blu Tack.
- Use acrylic paints to colour and design your own nesting dolls. Use Posca pens for finer detail. Not cheap, but perfect for the job. Lots of varieties.






To create a Cone:

- 1. Using plates of different sizes, cups, lids, anything round, draw round them to create circles of different sizes.
- 2. Cut them out.
- 3. Fold the circle in half. Open it out again.
- 4. Turn it around the other way and fold it in half again. This will give you a cross with the centre of the circle at the point of intersection.
- 5. Cut down any of the folds to the centre.
- 6. Curve the circle around itself to make the cone.
- 7. Start with the smallest cone this intervention works 'bottom up".










WORKING WITH DOORS





- Doors bought at The Works for £2 each in December 2020.
- This intervention enables two people to be separated from each other by 2 doors, with both doors closed. I stuck the doors together at the base.
- Use nesting dolls to represent, eg the Parent Self and the Inner Child. It could also be used for couples counselling or in fact any stuck relationship.
- What does it feel like to open your door and be faced with the closed door of the other person? And vice versa.
- What would it take for both parties to open their doors to each other? Which side would they unite on, and what would the implications be of that?
- If the Inner Child joins the Adult self, does he/she remain outside?
 Would being inside the adult be comforting and safe, or suffocating?


ROLES PLAYED IN FAMILIES CARDS



ROLES PLAYED IN ANGER CARDS


